Celebrate the opening of the New Generation Rollingstock Maintenance Centre in Wulkuraka at a free community open day.

The \$4.4 billion New Generation Rollingstock project involves the delivery of 75 six-car trains for the South East Queensland rail network. The Wulkuraka Maintenance Centre will be responsible for servicing and repairing these trains for the next 30 years.

Activities on the day include:

- Walking through a replica section of a New Generation Rollingstock train
- Touring the main maintenance building
- Learning about train maintenance
- Purchasing refreshments from local community groups
- Face painting and bouncing castles for the kids
- Enjoying performances from local indigenous groups and the Ipswich City Big Band.
