

Fares

How to calculate your fare?

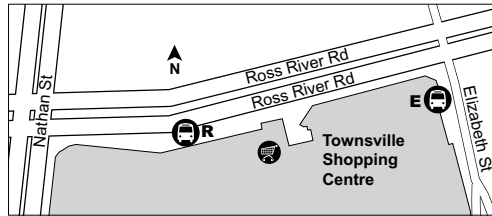
Fares are calculated based on the number of zones you travel through during your journey.

To calculate your fare, subtract the lowest zone you have travelled in or through, from the highest zone you have travelled in or through, and add one zone.

This will determine the correct number of zones you will be charged for.

Townsville Shopping Centre bus stops

There are two bus stops at Townsville Shopping Centre, marked on this timetable as:



E: on Elizabeth Street

R: on Ross River Road

Route 200/201

E: Services to CBD stop at Elizabeth St, Townsville Shopping Centre

R: Services to Kelso and Uni/Hospital stop at Ross River Road, Townsville Shopping Centre

Ticketing info

Translink single:

One-way ticket to reach your destination, including transfers within two hours on any Translink service.

Translink daily:

Unlimited travel within the zones purchased until the last service scheduled on the day of issue, valid on all Translink services.

Translink weekly:

Unlimited travel within the zones purchased for one week (seven consecutive days) from the date of issue, valid on all Translink services.

Timetable information

How to read this timetable

1. Use the route map to the two timing points your stop is located between.
2. Find these points on the timetable. Your bus is scheduled to arrive between the times shown for these points. For example, if your bus stop is situated between timing points A and C on the map, then the bus is scheduled to arrive between the times listed for A and C. Please be advised that the times shown are approximate. We ask that passengers be at the bus stop no less than five minutes prior to the scheduled departure time.

Travel tips

1. Pre-plan your trip with **MyTranslink** app, visit translink.com.au or call **1312 30**.
2. If you have a concession card, have it ready to show the driver.
3. Read the number top right on the approaching bus to check it's the service you want.
4. Raise your hand to signal to the driver that you want the bus to stop.
5. On the bus, find your seat. If you need to stand, hold on to a handle.
6. Ring the bell to let the driver know your stop is next, and remain seated until the bus stops.
7. Wait for the bus to move away and check the road is clear before crossing the road. If you are within 20m of a designated crossing, you must use that crossing.

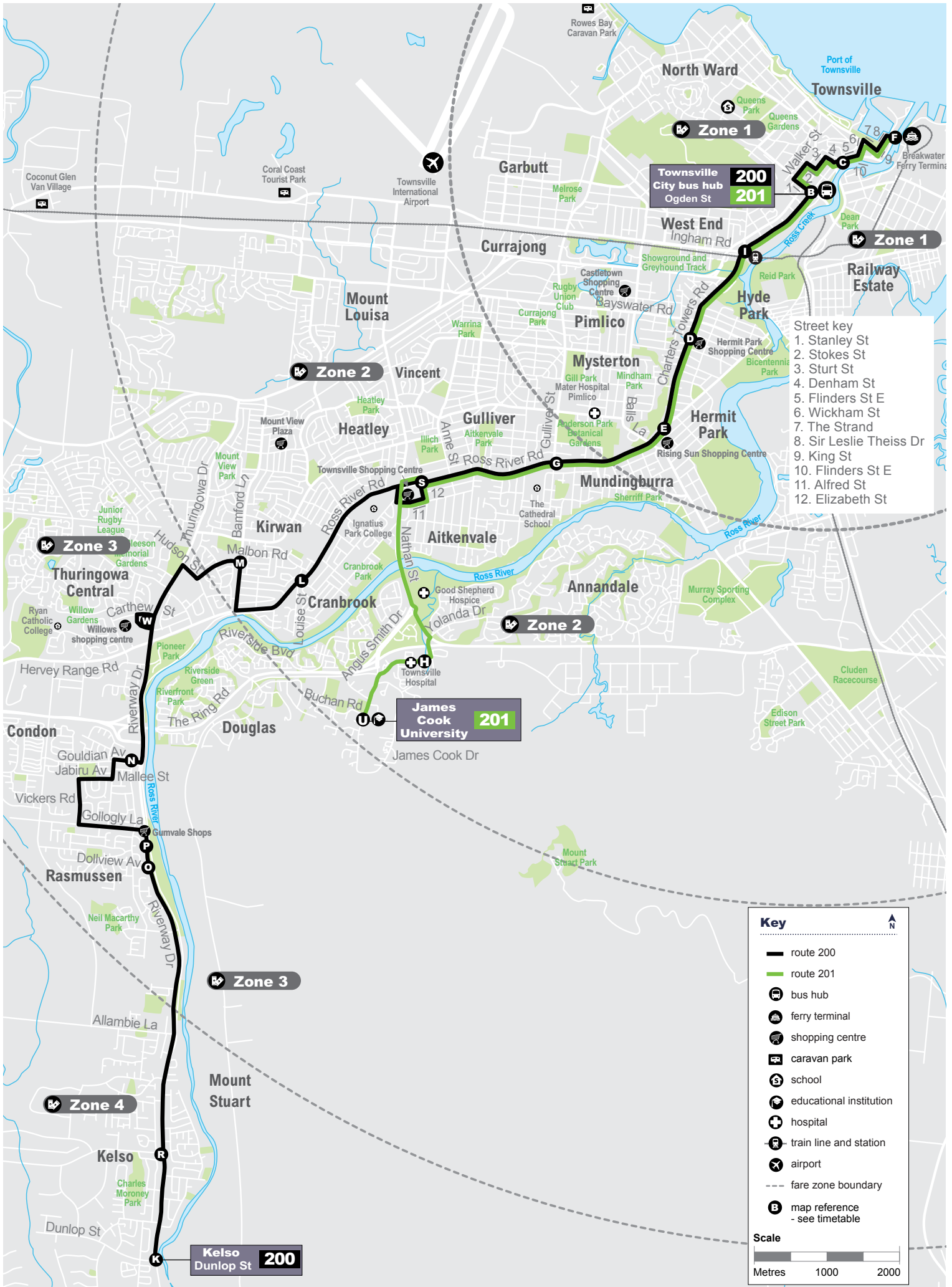
